
Clicking that arrow will show these hidden slide(s).

The Outline for Today

- Discuss <u>calls to be ready</u> for the last days and <u>warnings</u>
 that only a very few will be ready. Both scripture verses and the writings of Ellen White will be reviewed.
- 2. Discuss the <u>perils of the last days</u> ("such as never was before") and how the struggles of those days are to be a time of great personal growth as we allow the Lord to refine and purify us as gold.
- 3. Heart work needed for us to "stand" in those days.
- **4. An appeal to be ready**. Thoughts on "heart work" plus possible corporate and individual actions.



- We have arrived at the most significant point in the presentation series around which all three presentations are centered:
- Standing in the last days requires heart work without which we will be deceived and lose heaven.
- Most of us know when changes are needed in our spiritual lives but amidst the pressures of life, it's hard to change. Right?
- However, when we understand the great sense of urgency then ... [pause]
- "Please fasten your seat belts and move your seat backs and tray tables to their full and locked position."

Ellen White's Warnings (LDE 172.1)

"It is a solemn statement that I make to the church, that not one in twenty whose names are registered upon the church books are prepared to close their earthly history, and would be as verily without God and without hope in the world as the common sinner!"

[Read Slide Twice]

- If that number applies to those of us here, only a handful of people in this room will be ready for the testing of the last days.
- · However, if we were to conduct a secret survey, only a few of us would worried about being ready.
- This was me until recently: no worries.
- So, I ask you to consider the possibility that this number may apply to you and action will be required on your part.
- The good news is that we can all be prepared; it is a choice.
- · Let's push on.

Why One in Twenty?

"I asked the meaning of the shaking I had seen, and was shown that it would be caused by the straight testimony called forth by the counsel of the True Witness to the Laodiceans. This will have its effect upon the heart of the receiver, and will lead him to exalt the standard and pour forth the straight truth. Some will not bear this straight testimony. They will rise up against it, and this is what will cause a shaking among God's people." (CET 176.1)

• Ellen white described our lack of readiness as the Laodicean Condition.

Why One in Twenty?

"Those who have had opportunities to hear and receive of the truth and who have united with the Seventh-day Adventist church, calling themselves the commandment-keeping people of God, and yet possess no more vitality and consecration to God than do the nominal churches, will receive the plagues of God just as verily as the churches who oppose the law of God." (LDE 172.1)

- Truth does nothing for us if it does not go deep into the heart and change us.
- · Truth has to be assimilated.

Why One in Twenty?

"I saw that the testimony of the True Witness has not been half heeded. The solemn testimony upon which the destiny of the church hangs has been lightly esteemed, if not entirely disregarded. This testimony must work deep repentance; all who truly receive it will obey it, and be purified." (CET 176.2) Another great reference is 1T 186.1-2.

- This is the message of the parable of the 10 virgins:
 - All know and understand the Adventist message but in the foolish five, it had not worked a heart change!
 - Here's another clarification.

Why One in Twenty?

"Are God's People Prepared for False Miracles? It is fully time that every responsible worker should take his stand firmly on the word of God. This word is to be our defense when Satan works with such lying wonders that if it were possible he would deceive the very elect. It is then that those who have not stood firmly for the truth will unite with the unbelieving who love and make a lie. When these wonders are performed, when the sick are healed and other marvels are wrought, they will be deceived. Are we prepared for the perilous times that are right upon us? or are we standing where we will fall an easy prey to the wiles of the devil?" (5MR Miracles 352.1)

Why One in Twenty?

"Many Will Go From Us, Giving Heed to Seducing Spirits—A superficial faith results in a superficial experience.... The light given me has been very forcible that many would go out from us, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils. The Lord desires that every soul who claims to believe the truth shall have an intelligent knowledge of what is truth. False prophets will arise, and will deceive many. (5MR Miracles 352.3)

• So one problem is a superficial faith.

Why One in Twenty?

"Everything is to be shaken that can be shaken. Then does it not become every one to understand the reasons of our faith? In place of having so many sermons, there should be a more close searching of the Word of God, opening the Scriptures text by text, and searching for the strong evidence that sustain the fundamental doctrines that have brought us where we now are, upon the platform of eternal truth." (5MR Miracles 352.3)

Why One in Twenty?

"The numbers of this company [of believers] had lessened. Some had been shaken out and left by the way. The careless and indifferent, who did not join with those who prized victory and salvation enough to perseveringly plead and agonize for it, did not obtain it, and they were left behind in darkness, and their places were immediately filled by others taking hold of the truth and coming into the ranks. Evil angels still pressed around them, but could have no power over them." (CET 177.1)

• This comes from Ellen White's article on the Shaking.

Ellen White's Warnings

"The history of the rebellion of Dathan and Abiram is being repeated, and will be repeated till the close of time. Who will be on the Lord's side? Who will be deceived, and in their turn become deceivers?

"The Lord is soon to come. There must be a refining, winnowing process **in every church**, for there are among us wicked men who do not love the truth or honor God." (LDE 172.1)

H Ellen White's Warnings (DA 676.5)

"My Father is the husbandman. Every branch in Me that bears not fruit He takes away." While the graft is outwardly united with the vine, there may be no vital connection. Then there will be no growth or fruitfulness. So there may be an apparent connection with Christ without a real union with Him by faith. ...

H Ellen White's Warnings (DA 676.5)

"... A profession of religion places men in the church, but the character and conduct show whether they are in connection with Christ. If they bear no fruit, they are false branches. Their separation from Christ involves a ruin as complete as that represented by the dead branch. "If a man abide not in Me," said Christ, "he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned."

Ellen White's Warnings (GC 608.2)

"As the storm approaches, a large class who have professed faith in the third angel's message, but have not been sanctified through obedience to the truth, abandon their position and join the ranks of the opposition! By uniting with the world and partaking of its spirit, they have come to view matters in nearly the same light; and when the test is brought, they are prepared to choose the easy, popular side." (1 of 2)

• These are frightening thoughts. I'm forced to ask myself "might I be someone that would abandon the truth and join the opposition"?

One in Twenty!

What are our choices in handling the 1 in 20?

- 1. We can reject this number by:
 - A. Ignoring it,
 - B. saying It's not true,
 - C. assuming that we are ready or can easily get ready.
- 2. Accept the possibility that this is true which implies that we may need major changes and should discover what those are.

• This is some heavy lumber. We have two choices in handling such information:

[Next]

- When I hear these kind of warnings, I tend to zone out and started thinking about lunch.
- It's easy to think that this is just sensationalism or shock therapy. Please don't do that.
- · These are perilous times that demand our attention.

[Next]

- At this point, I'm only asking that we admit the possibility that there may be significant changes needed in our lives.
- So, are you still with me?
- Let's expand on this concept of only a few being saved.

Q: How Should We React to 1 in 20?

"12 Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; 13 but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy."
(1 Peter 4:12-13)

- Rejoice because these trials are necessary to purify us and prepare us for heaven.
- · For those that have made the necessary preparations, we will hear:
 - · "Well done my good and faithful servant."
- Though these will be the worst of times, we know:
 - · God will be in control
 - He has tailored our trials specifically for us because He knows that we can handle them and we
 will be purified by them.
- We have read the book and we know that God wins and we shall be delivered!!
- So how are we to react? [Press next to show "A: Rejoice"]

The Laodicean Condition

- +
- One in 20 being saved results from the Laodicean condition.
- Ellen White indicated this will be the primary issue in the church in the last days just as it was in 1844!
- Adventists are particularly susceptible because we "have the truth" and can be deceived by Satan to think that our correct knowledge is sufficient for our salvation.
- Since EGW indicates this is a church-wide issue, the church can and should play a major role in shining the light on Jesus and building every member up to be ready for the Lord's return!!

 When changes are needed in our lives, Christ can make those changes if we are willing to work with him!

The Laodicean Condition

"15 I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. 16 So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. 17 Because you say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing'—and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked!" (Revelation 3:15-17)


- Overlooking our own faults is part of our fallen nature, we are easily deceived by Satan into thinking that
 we are good enough!
- Satan stands ever vigilant to keep us away from any action that would correct any defects in our character.
- *** As a matter of fact, right now Satan does not want those of you to whom it applies to listen to the rest of this message!

Personal Testimony

- I started down this line of study and reasoning because I was in Laodicea! I was comfortable with just playing church.
- Thus, my object is to make sure that we **all**, as a church are wholly following the Lord and ready for the tough times ahead.
- · I want all of us to be in the first resurrection!

The Laodicean Condition

- Christ uses the phrase "vomit you out of my mouth."
 Why?
 - The "hot" are firmly in the kingdom.
 - The "cold" have the potential to be shown their need.
 - The "warm" don't see any need to change and won't listen or hear words of warning. This the hardest group to reach with the Gospel!

- Ellen White tends to present this in the negative: the results of not being **ready**.
- However, we have a choice: be the 1 in 20 that is saved or be in the 19 or so that are lost.
- We will continue emphasizing this choice as we continue.

Warnings from Christ

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²² Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' ²³ And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'." (Matthew 7:21-23)

- Let me rephrase:
 - Have we not taught Sabbath School? Served on boards? Served as Elder, Deacon, Deaconess...
 - Have we not studied and understood all the Adventist doctrine and end time scenarios?
- But Christs response is still "I never knew you."
- Bottom line:
 - A knowledge of the truth and seeking salvation by works will not save us.
 - A heart change must accompany a knowledge of the truth.
 - Then, works become a love response to that heart change.

Warnings from Christ

"13 Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. ¹⁴ Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it." (Matthew 7:13-14)

"Few" here corresponds to Ellen White's "Not 1 in 20".

Warnings from Christ

"34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. 35 For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. 36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man." (Luke 21:34-36)

- 14 Times Christ says watch or take heed as applied to being ready for these last days.
- 24 times in the New Testament.

Bottom line: We have been warned. What we do with that warning is our choice.

The Perils of the Last Days: - Underestimating the greatness of the struggle - Not being spiritually prepared.

A Time Such as Never Has Been

"At that time Michael shall stand up, the great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people; and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, every one who is found written in the book." (Daniel 12:1)

"The persecutions of Protestants by Romanism [Dark Ages], by which the religion of Jesus Christ was almost annihilated, will be more than rivaled when Protestantism and popery are combined.

The commandment-keeping people of God erelong will be placed in a most trying position; but all those who have walked in the light, and diffused the light, will realize that God interposes in their behalf."

(Mar 194.3)

• Yes, the trying of the last days will be very tough but God promises to get us through the trials as he refines us like gold.

"Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep; ²⁶ In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren; ²⁷ In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness." (2 Corinthians 11:25-27)


Anti-Hate Speech Surveillance Technology

Roxanne is marketed as a multiplatform analytical tool to evaluate speech and facial patterns in order to create visual mapping for authorities and identity suspects. ROXANNE is a new breed of surveillance technology in the process of development and currently being backed by both An Garda Síochána and the PSNI to bring into use. It is a biometrics based platform ostensibly to monitor and crack down on organized crime. An additional application of ROXANNE which its creators advertise freely is the ability to monitor those guilty of alleged hate speech and political extremism. (View article)

Hate speech, political extremism:

- 1. Those that believe in seven literal days of creation
- 2. Those that say that there is no global warming
- 3. Those that keep the Sabbath
- 4. Republicans
- 5. Conservatives
- 6. Those that use the wrong pronouns.
- 7. And the list goes on to anyone that is not an enthusiastic supporter of all the current list of items currently considered as "politically correct".

The object is complete thought control to create a people incapable of turning towards God. Praise God that He will cut this time short or else not oven the very elect would survive!



Evangelicals Are a Very Important Problem

French Minister of Interior Gérald Darmanin:

" "Evangelicals are a very important problem", only to add, "obviously not [a problem] of the same nature than the Islamism that makes terrorist attacks and deaths".

One day before, speaking about the <u>controversial anti-</u> <u>separatism law</u> that is expected to be passed soon, he told radio broadcaster *France Inter*: "We cannot discuss with people who refuse to write on paper that the **law of the Republic is superior to the law of God**".". - · This is a direct attach on God and God's law.
- Not a surprise coming from France but a sign of the times.

A Time Such as Never Has Been

"... and when they had called for the apostles and beaten *them*, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. ⁴¹ **So they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for His name.** ⁴² And daily in the temple, and in every house, they did not cease teaching and preaching Jesus *as* the Christ." (Acts 5:40-42)

The New World Order (NOW)

"...it is lawful for a man to succor his own need by means of another's property by taking it either openly or secretly; nor is this, properly speaking, theft and robbery... It is not theft, properly speaking, to take secretly and use another's property in a case of extreme need; because that which he takes for the support of his life becomes his own property by reason of that need...In a case of a like need, a man may also take secretly another's property in order to succor his neighbor in need." (7th article of Thomas Aquinas)

So, as Rome sees it, property is for common good. You may own it, but it is for common good. Whatever you have that is more than you need will be given to others. In South Africa, if your house is vacant, squatters may come in to occupy your home, and nothing is done to remove them, while you continue to pay the bills. Similarly, police don't come when you are robbed (per Walter Veith).

Our Attitude Towards the Tough Times "2 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into divers trials [temptations]; 3 Knowing this, that the trying of your faith works patience. 4 But let patience have her perfect work, that you may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing." (James 1:2-4)

[Read below first]

The Greek work for temptation is also translated as trial or testing; so...

[Read slide twice using trial]

- · As hard as this sounds, we must rejoice in the trials that shall try us knowing that God is in control.
- Let's dig a little deeper into this.

- Struggles are necessary to prepare us for the trials of these last days as well as for heaven.
- God does not look at an issue and then look around for someone to give it to!! No!
- God looks at each of us and asks "what is most needed in this life at this moment" and then He tailors the trials to our specific needs as well as our ability to handle such trials!!

"When we expect peace, we frequently have distrust and doubt because we find ourselves plunged into trials we cannot avoid. In these trials we are having the answers to our prayers. In order for us to be purified, the fire of affliction must kindle upon us, and our will must be brought into conformity to the will of God. In order to be conformed to the image of our Savior, we pass through a most painful process of refining." (OFC 295.2)

[Read slide first]

Here we see the necessity of the trials in life and specifically of the last days.

"The Lord in His providence brings men where He can test their moral powers and reveal their motives of action, that they may improve what is right in themselves and put away that which is wrong. God would have His servants become acquainted with the moral machinery of their own hearts. In order to bring this about, He often permits the fire of affliction to assail them that they may become purified." (CCh 54.7)

"You must have an experience for yourselves, which shall be founded in God. Then can you stand amid the perils of the last days and be purified and not consumed by the fire of affliction through which all the saints must pass in order to have the impurities removed from their character preparatory to receiving the finishing touch of immortality." (2T 118.3)

[→ For more suffering with Jesus] [Read slide first]

Herein is the bottom line on the tribulation:

- For the believer, these struggles are absolutely essential for our purification.
- · We should both expect the trials and embrace them.
- For those who submit to the Holy Spirit's leading, the sufferings of this time will be a joyous time of great spiritual growth through which we are being fitted for heaven.

Tough Times but HOPE!

"13 There has no testing overtaken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tested above that you are able; but will with the testing also make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it." (Hebrews 10:12-13)

[Read highlighted again, slowly with emphasis]

- Note that Greek for testing is also translated as temptation
- Consider also this scripture

Tough Times but HOPE!

¹¹ For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. ¹² Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. ¹³ And you will seek Me and find *Me*, when you search for Me with all your heart. (Jeremiah 29:11-13)

"...to give you a future and a hope."

Tough Times but HOPE!

"When everything looks most forbidding, then the Lord will reveal His power to His faithful ones. When the nation for which God has worked in such a marvelous manner, and over which He has spread the shield of Omnipotence, abandons Protestant principles, and through its legislature gives countenance and support to Romanism in limiting religious liberty, then God will work in His own power for His people that are true. The tyranny of Rome will be exercised, but Christ is our refuge." (Mar 194.4)



Tough Times Summary

- Satan will be in almost total control of the world and will delight in creating as much pain as possible for everyone.
- Chaos and anarchy, now extant, will become pervasive.
- Famines and great shortages will be world wide.
- There will be only two classes in society: the elite who own everything and serfs who have no possessions or rights.
- Thought control (worshiping on Sabbath, green score, conservative views disallowed). This is programed through buying and selling limits, travel controls, persecution ...



Chaos:

- Think about much Mexico today or Israel.
- Riots and demonstrations everywhere caused by extreme polarization of the populations.

It's a Matter of Priorities

- Would you agree that if our relationship with the Lord may not what it should be, that, in the end, it is a matter of our priorities?
- Is it not clear that many of the things of this world are designed to redirect our priorities, to keep us busy?

The reason for this series of presentation to motivate us to be ready by:

- Showing that very little time remaining for this world and the Lord's return.

 - "Eye hath not seen nor ear heard nor entered into the heart of man the things that God has prepared for those that love Him."
- Showing that very tough times lie ahead such that we may despair of even life.

- Showing us that we must be have a character that will pass the tests that lie ahead.
 - Character and the stars in our crown (people led to Christ) are all we take with us to heaven.

Here is the summary: we have two years, perhaps a little more, to develop this character which is "Christ in us, the hope of glory."

The 1 Mile Race Analogy



"A revival of true godliness among us is the greatest and most urgent of all our needs. To seek this should be our first work. There must be earnest effort to obtain the blessing of the Lord, not because God is not willing to bestow His blessing upon us, but because we are unprepared to receive it. Our heavenly Father is more willing to give His Holy Spirit to them that ask Him, than are earthly parents to give good gifts to their children. But it is our work, by confession, humiliation, repentance, and earnest prayer, to fulfill the conditions upon which God has promised to grant us His blessing." (True Revival 9.1)

True Godliness Through the Holy Spirit

"The lapse of time has wrought no change in Christ's parting promise to send the Holy Spirit as His representative. It is not because of any restriction on the part of God that the riches of His grace do not flow earthward to men. If the fulfillment of the promise is not seen as it might be, it is because the promise is not appreciated as it should be. If all were willing, all would be filled with the Spirit. Wherever the need of the Holy Spirit is a matter little thought of, there is seen spiritual drought, spiritual darkness, spiritual declension and death. Whenever minor matters occupy the attention, the divine power which is necessary for the growth and prosperity of the church, and which would bring all other blessings in its train, is lacking, though offered in infinite plenitude." 

Revival and Reformation Defined

"A revival and a reformation must take place, under the ministration of the Holy Spirit. Revival and reformation are two different things.

"Revival is a renewal of spiritual life, a quickening of the powers of mind and heart, a resurrection from spiritual death.

"Reformation signifies a reorganization, a change in ideas and theories, habits and practices. Reformation will not bring forth the good fruit of righteousness unless it is connected with the revival of the Spirit. Revival and reformation are to do their appointed work, and in doing this work they must blend."

Standing in the Evil Day

- Ellen White said the Lord did not come in 1800's because there was no people ready for the Holy Spirit.
- Being able to stand at the end of time means that we must be ready to receive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit called the "Latter Rain."
- Receiving the Latter Rain requires proper character traits arising from a heart totally committed to God.
- To get a view of what that means to us, let's take a
 quick look at the Former Rain in the book of Acts.

"Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, ² fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. ³ Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. ⁴ Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others." (Philippians 2:1-4)







10 Days in the Upper Room

The prayer experience in the Upper Room launched a life of prayer for the disciples' entire ministry. Through prayer they developed trusting hearts. Through prayer they established an attitude of dependence on the Almighty. Through prayer they acknowledged their weakness and sought His strength. Through prayer they admitted their ignorance and sought His wisdom. The disciples openly recognized their limitations and cried out for His all-sufficient power. They recognized they could never reach the world with the gospel without the presence and power of the Holy Spirit working through them. Pentecost was the result of heartfelt intercession!! (10 Days, page 11, emphasis added)

Heart Change

"By what means shall [we] repress [our] evil propensities, and develop that which is noble and good in [our] characters? Let us heed the words, "Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God." [1 Corinthians 10:31.] Here is a principle that is to underlie every motive, thought, and act. Unholy passions must be crucified. They will clamor for indulgence, but God has implanted in the heart high and holy purposes and desires, and these need not be debased. It is only when we refuse to submit to the control of reason and conscience that we are dragged down. Paul declared, "I can do all things through Christ." (GW 127.3)

Heart Change



 - [David before Goliath killed a bear and a lion (1 Samuel 17:34-37); learned to use sling to protect his flock; had lots of quiet time with the Lord. Also note anointing before becoming king.]
- [Best path]
- [Go it alone] Frequently I try to go it alone, and do face plants on the concrete. I seem to be a slow learner.
- [Trust] The only thing we can give the Lord is our wills. Using our will, we must choose to trust Him with everything. Bottom line is that the only way to get through the coming trials is to choose to let Him lead and to do all He asks us to do. This may be specific actions towards others or individually as part of God's purifying process. [Pause]

Notes on Holy Spirit from EGW:

The lapse of time has wrought no change in Christ's parting promise to send the Holy Spirit as His representative. It is not because of any restriction on the part of God that the riches of His grace do not flow earthward to men. If the fulfillment of the promise is not seen as it might be, it is because the promise is not appreciated as it should be. If all were willing, all would be filled with the Spirit. Wherever the need of the Holy Spirit is a matter little thought of, there is seen spiritual drought, spiritual darkness, spiritual declension and death. Whenever minor matters occupy the attention, the divine power which is necessary for the growth and prosperity of the church [and to survive the last days], and which would bring all other blessings in its train, is lacking, though offered in infinite plenitude. (AA 50.1)

Since this is the means by which we are to receive power, why do we not hunger and thirst for the gift of the Spirit? Why do we not talk of it, pray for it, and preach concerning it? The Lord is more willing to give the

Holy Spirit to those who serve Him than parents are to give good gifts to their children. For the daily baptism of the Spirit every worker should offer his petition to God. Companies of Christian workers should gather to ask for special help, for heavenly wisdom, that they may know how to plan and execute wisely. Especially should they pray that God will baptize His chosen ambassadors in mission fields with a rich measure of His Spirit. The presence of the Spirit with God's workers will give the proclamation of truth a power that not all the honor or glory of the world could give. (AA 50.2)

It is true that in the time of the end, when God's work in the earth is closing, the earnest efforts put forth by consecrated believers under the guidance of the Holy Spirit are to be accompanied by special tokens of divine favor. Under the figure of the early and the latter rain, that falls in Eastern lands at seedtime and harvest, the Hebrew prophets foretold the bestowal of spiritual grace in extraordinary measure upon God's church. The outpouring of the Spirit in the days of the apostles was the beginning of the early, or former, rain, and glorious was the result. To the end of time the presence of the Spirit is to abide with the true church. (AA 54.2)

But near the close of earth's harvest, a special bestowal of spiritual grace is promised to prepare the church for the coming of the Son of man. This outpouring of the Spirit is likened to the falling of the latter rain; and it is for this added power that Christians are to send their petitions to the Lord of the harvest "in the time of the latter rain." In response, "the Lord shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain." "He will cause to come down ... the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain," (Zechariah 10:1; Joel 2:23). (AA 55.1)

But unless the members of God's church today have a living connection with the Source of all spiritual growth, they will not be ready for the time of reaping. Unless they keep their lamps trimmed and burning, they will fail of receiving added grace in times of special need. (AA 55.2)

Those only who are constantly receiving fresh supplies of grace, will have power proportionate to their daily need and their ability to use that power. Instead of looking forward to some future time when, through a special endowment of spiritual power, they will receive a miraculous fitting up for soul winning, they are yielding themselves daily to God, that He may make them vessels meet for His use. Daily they are improving the opportunities for service that lie within their reach. Daily they are witnessing for the Master wherever they may be, whether in some humble sphere of labor in the home, or in a public field of usefulness. (AA 55.3)






